Ontario City Council met in special session on March 27, 2007 in the City Offices, with Council President Dave Metzger presiding. The meeting opened at 6:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The following persons were in attendance when roll was called: Council members Bobby Shook, Charlotte Hellinger, Paul Williams, Mark Weidemyre, Dan Zeiter and Carol Shrader; Mr. Metzger; Mayor Kenneth Bender; Assistant Law Director Ryan Hoovler; Service/Safety Director Chuck Au; and Clerk of Council Cathy VanAuker. A number of interested citizens were present in the audience.

Mr. Weidemyre made a motion to excuse Mrs. Konczak from this evening's meeting. Mrs. Hellinger seconded the motion. At roll call, six members voted Aye, zero Nay, and the motion passed.

Mr. Zeiter made a motion to excuse Mrs. Thomas and accept Mr. Hoovler in her place. Mr. Weidemyre seconded the motion. At roll call, six members voted Aye, zero Nay, and the motion passed.

Mr. Metzger stated the special meeting was called for Ordinance No. 07-16. He then opened the floor for questions or concerns and offered time to review the plans.

- In response to Mr. Metzger's question if this property has the specification that it can not open until the streets are completed, Mr. Winfrey of Richland Engineering stated that was his understanding.
- Mayor Bender commented this was recommended by the Planning Commission.
- Mayor Bender added that Menards intends to have all of the street improvements completed before opening the store which includes the Home Road extension.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 07-16

(SECOND READING) AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PLAT FOR WALKER LAKE POINT ONTARIO, OHIO, TO THE CITY OF ONTARIO, OHIO.

Mr. Zeiter made a motion to suspend the rules requiring the reading of Ordinance No. 07-16 on three separate days. Mrs. Shrader seconded the motion. At roll call, five members voted Aye, one Nay vote by Mrs. Hellinger, and the motion to suspend the rules failed. Mr. Williams read Ordinance No. 07-16 for the second time, by title only.
